Daily Prayers for week beginning 6th September

6th • We pray today for all those facing tensions at home and for couples facing or going through separation or divorce. For any children who are caught up in family tensions, and ask for God's grace and mercy to be at work in each of these situations and for all those involved.

- For the residents of Hill View, Knoll Park and Brean Court in Brean.

7th • We pray today for all single parent families coping with pressures of maintaining family life especially during these challenging times.

- For the residents of Golf Links Road, Saxondale Avenue, Links Close and Links Gardens in Burnham-on-Sea.

8th • We pray today for all those who are struggling to make ends meet financially. For self-employed workers unsure of their future for those on zero hours contracts, and those living on benefits or receiving other financial assistance.

- For the residents of Grass Road and St Bridget's Close in Brean.

9th • We pray today for those facing the possibility of losing their home and for those already living in a hostel or for some seeking shelter somewhere on the streets. For God's safety and protection for them.

- For the residents of Naish Road, Oak Tree Place, Blytheway and Newton Way in Burnham-on-Sea.

10th • We pray today for Brean Parish Council and for all those who serve on it at this time. We pray that they may make the best possible decisions for the community they represent. For

those who use the Village Hall as part of the groups and organisations that meet there, including the Brean Community Hub.

- For the residents of Weston Road in Brean.

11th • We pray today for all those who are grieving the loss of someone who has died. For those who tend and care for them like our local funeral directors and those who look after the churchyards and cemeteries here so that they can be places of comfort. For those who minister to them and provide pastoral care in the times that follow bereavement, including our team of Lay Pastoral Assistants.

- For the residents of Ash Tree Road, Ash Tree Place, Ash Tree Close and Ash Tree Crescent in Burnham-on-Sea.
